Connie attended schools in Eureka. When she started school, the only place you could go to kindergarten was with the Catholic nuns, but when she went to sign up the class was full. Since her mom knew the 1st grade teacher, she just started first grade. She was

the youngest in her class and she graduated when she was 17. In high school she received the Betty Crocker Homemaking Award. She also was a member of the drill team. She graduated 5th in a class of 19.

She worked at several jobs including her favorites, the telephone office in Eureka and Payson and Juab High School as the counseling secretary.
