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**MINUTES OF A COUNCIL WORK SESSION
HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS
MARCH 21, 2012**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James E. DeGraffenried at 6:03 pm. Council Members attending: Keith Broadhead, Matthew Carr, James Linford, Richard Payne and Rick Steele.

Others present: City Manager Ben Reeves, Community Development Director Dennis Marker, Public Works Director Wade Eva, Vernon Mortensen, Spencer Healey, and Brent Norton.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Presentation by Vernon Mortensen, Utelite Inc. & Wade Eva, Public Works Director, regarding road improvement options (e.g. chip sealing products & Interlocal agreements with neighboring cities)

Director Eva reported 2 years ago the City participated in a chip seal project with Payson, Springville, and Spanish Fork with negative results. Director Eva suggested trying the chip seal project again this year using the chips Mr. Mortensen is introducing.

Mr. Mortensen indicated Utelite Corporation has been in business for 50 years supplying aggregate. Chip seal has been used as a surface treatment since the 1920's. The use of chip seal prolongs the life of the roadway. He indicated the light weight aggregate is used more often because it bonds better on the roadway therefore reducing windshield breakage, as well as additional benefits.

City Manager Reeves was told by Mr. Mortensen there may be some shearing of the aggregate if it is overlaid on the roads that were damaged during the last project. Director Eva would like to cover a couple of the roads from the last project as well as covering roadways that are "clean". He is interested in seeing the way the roadways hold up under both circumstances.

Council Member Payne requested a map of where the chip seal and the rejuvenation would be used. Mr. Mortensen offered 2 semi-loads of slurry seal free of charge to use in a low volume roadway which the City graciously accepted.

Mr. Mortensen thanked the Mayor and Council Members for allowing him to address them this evening.
