**MINUTES OF A COUNCIL WORK SESSION

APRIL 27, 2011**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James E. DeGraffenried at 6:02 pm. Council Members attending: Filip Askerlund, Martin Green, James Linford, Rick Steele and Brent Vincent.

Others attending: City Manager Ben Reeves, Community Development Director Dennis Marker, and Dennis Barnes.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

City Manager Reeves reported he and Dennis Marker met with Dave Tuckett Payson City Manager with regard to rescheduling the Commission Meeting addressing a boundary line between Santaquin and Payson. It was determined that a request for a meeting extension was sent and

Budget review

City Manager Reeves led the budget discussion. He indicated that the preliminary budget was a work in progress but because the issues of the last two days the budget is not balanced but will be within the a few days.

City Manager Reeves reported he had "rolled out" the proposed building consolidation.

Dennis Barnes requested time to give a review of the water issue at Center and approximately 1100 North. It was reported that the culinary water line settled and pulled from the cross pipe in the middle of the road causing approximately ½ block of road destruction. The water lines are back in working order. Mayor DeGraffenried and City Manager Reeves thanked Mr. Barnes and the other City Employees for their hard work and dedication.

City Manager Reeves continued with the budget review. The complete proposed budget will be available for review at the City Office and will be scheduled for Public Hearing within the month of May.
