MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS APRIL 06, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James E. DeGraffenried at 6:00 pm. Council Members attending: Filip Askerlund, James Linford, Rick Steele and Brent Vincent.

Others attending: City Manager Ben Reeves and Community Development Director Dennis Marker.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Update on the 400 E Main Street Project

Mr. Marker updated the Mayor and Council Members on the up coming Main Street Project. It was reported that current Utah County is supplying \$3.38 million dollars, UDOT supplying \$.2 million, and the City contributing approximately \$.05 million.

Mr. Marker discussed the placement of street lighting, new sidewalk, and planter boxes. See attachment "A" for Mr. Marker's presentation. After the discussion, Option 1 was decided on.

Discussion on possible UTA Routes


Mr. Marker reported he had met with the UTA Representatives this past week. He indicated the increase in the sales tax would be in effect beginning July 2011. 400 East/Main Street Project



City Council Awarded the Base Bid Contract to Condie Construction on March 23, 2011.

Based on awarded bid amount there is approximately 0.5 million remaining for construction.

400 East/Main Street Project Additives



Improvements behind all curb and gutter on Main from 200 E. to 300 E. <u>Includes:</u> undergrounding utilities, new sidewalk and planter boxes, decorative street lights.

<u>Does not include:</u> moving existing curb & gutter, storm drain improvements, decorative concrete between planters.

<u>Issues:</u> What to do with planter area (between sidewalk and curb) Transitions from sidewalk to existing curbing, road work still needed. Future UDOT funds will be focused inside curb and gutter.

400 East/Main Street Project Additives



Fully construct south half of Main between 200 E. and 300 E.

<u>Includes:</u> Full improvements on south half of road, storm drain system, decorative lighting only on south side(?), planter boxes on south side. Undergrounding of utilities.

<u>Issues</u>: Work in road way will extend beyond half width and likely include overlay of entire Main Street surface (wasted \$\$\$)

400 East/Main Street Project Additives

Option 3



Improvements behind south side curb and gutter between 100 E. & 300 E.

<u>Includes:</u> undergrounding utilities, new sidewalk and planter boxes, decorative street lights (one side?).

<u>Does not include:</u> moving existing curb & gutter, storm drain improvements, decorative concrete between planters.

<u>Issues</u>: What to do with planter area (between sidewalk and curb) Transitions from sidewalk to existing curbing, road work still needed.
