Notice of award for construction of the Water Reclamation Facility contingent upon closing of the bonds

City Manager Reeves reported the bids submitted for the Wastewater Reclamation Facility Project were higher than the Engineers estimates for the project. He indicated that he, Mayor DeGraffenried, Council Member Linford, and J-U-B Representatives met with Department of Water Quality Representatives to discuss funding of the project. The Council Members were told the Department of Water Quality would cover the funding gap associated with the bids coming in higher by offering lower interest rates (from 3% to 1%) which would allow maintaining the duration and payment amount, but would require a new time line and "additional hoops that need to be jumped through".

Mr. Ward indicated a new Resolution would need to be adopted which would outline new bond parameters. He outlined the following time line associated with the new "hoops".

Resolution 12-01-2010, A Resolution authorizing Engineering Services for the Water Reclamation Facility

Mr. Lindley reviewed the need for adoption of the resolution as well as reviewed the increase in the costs for each task associated with the project (see Resolution 12-01-2010 for details). Mr. Lindley indicated the bids for the project came in greater than anticipated. The bids all included Davis Bacon wages which increased the labor rates and increased the overall bid amount. He indicated there are places where project costs could be decreased and recommended reviewing the plans. He said upon completion of the project all lagoon water could be accepted at this facility.

City Manager Reeves indicated the Department of Water Quality Representatives Ed McCauley and Lisa Nelson were in favor of funding the complete project as designed. That is why they suggested revamping the interest rate. Mr. McCauley is working to keeping the USDA funding package untouched.

Council Member Linford moved to approve Resolution 12-01-2010, A Resolution authorizing Engineering Services for the Water Reclamation Facility. Council Member Green seconded the motion. Council Member Askerlund agrees with all items included in the bid but the building permit fee. Council Member Askerlund asked Mr. Lindley if the Council Members will be approving additional fees for the Engineering at a later date. Mr. Lindley indicated the Mayor and Council Members will be notified at a time the funding reaches a certain percent. City

Manager Reeves indicated that, for a cost, the Engineers could do a monthly, bimonthly or quarterly update of the project. After the discussion, Council Members Askerlund, Green, Linford, Steele, and Vincent voted unanimously in favor of the motion through a roll call vote.
