## **REPORTS OF OFFICERS, STAFF, BOARDS, AND COMMITTEES**

Director of Public Safety Howard reported there were 2088 calls for service since the first of the year. He also reported there have been 139 nuisance issues addressed. Director Howard voiced his concern with the repeat offenders of the nuisance ordinance. The process of enforcing a nuisance is very lengthy and he suggested the ordinance be reviewed and changes made.

Council Member Askerlund voiced his concern with the area around Maverik that is not being maintained. He reported a "fire break" will be constructed within the next week or so.

City Planner Marker reported the Planning Commission will be reviewing assessory apartment issues.

Council Member Askerlund was told within the next couple of months, the reclamation of the "pit site" on SR198 would begin. If the plant were to remain open through the winter months, the reclamation would transpire in the early spring.

### ***Discussion and possible action with regard to the City owned home on Orchard Lane***

An asbestos report will be ordered for the home on Orchard Lane. Upon receipt of the asbestos report the home will be used for training for the Public Safety Department, burned and the debris taken to the City Landfill.

Council Member Linford moved to direct staff to take care of moving forward with training within, and destruction of, the property. Council Member Askerlund seconded the motion. Council Members Askerlund, Green, Linford, and Steele voted in the affirmative.


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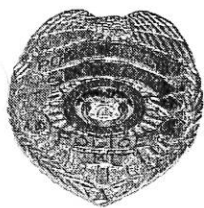
