**CHERRY ORCHARD ESTATES**

City Engineer Fullmer reviewed, with those in attendance, the plans for a 7 lot subdivision to be located at approximately 200 East 500 North (East side of Road).

Council member Callaway indicated he was apposed to the developers not providing anything back to the City. He indicated he would not be in favor of this subdivision unless the developer donated something to the City. Mr. Caines objected to Council member Callaway's comment. "We must get something back from the developers. They haven't contributed on one thing," Council member Callaway indicated.


All of the Council members participated in further discussion.
