PM<sub>10</sub> pollutants are particles which can aggravate the respiratory system in the elderly, young children, and those with respiratory ailments. SO<sub>2</sub> or sulfur dioxide in combination with moisture in the air can form sulfuric acid or what is commonly referred to as acid rain. NO<sub>x</sub> or nitrous oxides are chemicals that in the atmosphere create a brown haze or "brown cloud" when combined with moisture and exposed to light. VOC, or volatile organic compounds consist of chemicals such as formaldehyde, benzene, toluene, xylene, and acetaldehyde. The combination of NO<sub>x</sub> with VOC in the atmosphere also create ozone.

Testing of emissions from the stack are to be done with 45 day advance notification with a meeting between the Division of Air Quality and the Owner/Operator 30 days prior to the testing.

In addition to the previously listed pollutants and with proper permits, asphalt plants can burn used oils which may contain the following contaminants: Arsenic, Cadmium, Chromium, Lead, Halogenated compounds (Chlorinated, Flourinated, Brominated), and sulfur.

Valley Aspect Plan at the time of the inspection estimated the emissions to be below the stated emission thats.

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This stimmer was taken from report DAQC-827-97 dated 5.597.

The allowable pollutants listed are for the current DAQ permit production rates. These levels could decrease or increase for the Santaquin site depending on the production rate they seek permits for. As can be seen from the data, Valley asphalt did not show they exceeded the allowed levels of pollutants. If they burn natural gas and use best available technology for the control of the emissions from all potential pollution sources they would continue to be well below the allowable limits placed on them.

However, we are currently not subject to the level of pollutants that Valley Asphalt has reported because of the limited scope of the current gravel mining operations at the Santaquin Valley Asphalt pit. This will change if an expanded operation is allowed through the annexation and approval of the Industrial 2 Zoning Ordinance and Approval Order

between Valley Asphalt and the City of Santaquin.

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Concerned Citizens,

Being somewhat confused about the facts surrounding the Valley Asphalt proposed annexation, I contacted Utah County Planning and Zoning and spoke with several people who dealt with county zoning regulations. The following are facts obtained.

- 1) The current county zoning, **CE1**, will <u>never</u> allow Valley Asphalt to make concrete nor asphalt at the Santaguin pit.
- 2) If the CE1 is changed to remove mining as a conditional use, which is very possible, and that is currently on their agenda to address, Valley would be able to take what they can from the 50 acres at the Santaquin pit and then have to shut down.
- 3) The "grandfather clause" simply allows Valley Asphalt to be able to continue as they are, no expansion, no asphalt, and no concrete. This clause will go into effect **only** if there is a zoning change.
- 4) Valley Asphalt does not have a crusher permit for the Santaquin Site. To get one they would need to apply to the County Board of Adjustments, a public meeting would be held to get the sentiment of the people, the board would then vote on whether or not to give them a crusher permit. THE CRUSHER AT THE SITE IS ILLEGAL. To expand the size of the plant the same process would have to be followed.
- 5) \*\*Note: Application for a cement plant or a concrete plant in a CE1 zone would not even be accepted..
- 6) VALLEY ASPHALT WANTS TO ANNEX THE SANTAQUIN PIT INTO OUR CITY BECAUSE THEY CANNOT GET WHAT THEY WANT FROM THE COUNTY.
- 7) If annexation by Valley Asphalt is allowed, the Santaquin pit would 1) expand to approximately 3 times its current size, 2) asphalt would be made, 3) concrete would be mixed. Traffic would increase tremendously we would become the headquarters for Valley Asphalt.

A lot of money is to be made here, but it is **not** by Santaquin City, it is by Valley Asphalt. That money will be made at the expense of our community. The quality of life we all enjoy will be gone, and so will other industrial business that would really help this community.

Experience has proven that fines for violation of air quality restrictions etc., do not prevent future violations. The crusher at the Santaquin pit is listed by the county as illegal.

Will other industry want to build in the shadow of a 150-200 acre gravel pit? Visit other pits and decide for yourself. Ask questions and understand the real sentiment the county has towards Valley Asphalt and gravel pits. A mistake here by the Santaquin City Council will affect all of us, and our children.

# Santaquin residents don't aim to pave way for asphalt plant

#### Hearing Tuesday on annexation for firm's expansion

SANTAQUIN — Valley Asphalt wants to annex 174 acres here to enable it to expand its operations into a full-fledged concrete and asphalt batch plant, which could lead to an economic boom for this town just off I-15 in south Utah County.

But as the time nears for a public hearing Tuesday, residents are gearing up to fight the asphalt and concrete company and the city, which seems to be leaning toward letting the company come in. Some residents fear their quality of life will be compromised.

Valley Asphalt is now located in Leland, just south of Spanish Fork.

The company owns a gravel pit just east of Santaquin that has been in operation since the 1930s, said Richard Bradford, executive director of Utah Valley Economic Development Association and a consultant working for the city.

Bradford said most city officials are leaning toward approving the batch plant if adequate safeguards are built into the ordinances.

Mayor Keith Broadhead refused to discuss the issue with the Deseret News. He also declined to discuss the low bid that was recently given Valley Asphalt to repave some 30 blocks of Santaquin. Valley Asphalt's bid was some \$40,000 below the next closest bid.

Broadhead said questioning the bid "was the most stupidest question I've ever heard."

One other councilman, Kirk Greenhalgh, declined to comment.

Councilman Frank Staheli said Valley Asphalt needed to annex into Santaquin to build the batch plant and expand the gravel pit operation. The county "critical environment" zone the pit is in doesn't allow much expansion.

"We are writing an industrial zone that should accommodate that if we brought them in," Staheli said. The city doesn't have the necessary zone now, he added. Staheli called the new zone generic but said Valley Asphalt precipitated it.

Councilman Lynn Adams said city zoning and planning officials were also working on a mining ordinance, which the city now lacks but would need to control the gravel pit operation. If the annexation were approved, the city would benefit from better control over Valley Asphalt, an expanded tax base and increased sales of

water and natural gas, he said.

The council has also discussed receiving a royalty per ton from the gravel pit, he said.

Other members of the council could not be reached. A phone cal to Valley Asphalt was not returned.

Meanwhile, residents who oppose the annexation are gearing uto keep Valley Asphalt out. Colleen Wilson and her husband are self-described leaders of the opposition and are circulating petition against the proposal. She said while circulating the petitions she found that many residents were unaware that Valley Asphalt wanted to expand its operations into Santaquin.

She cited concerns with increased truck traffic both through Santaquin and between Santaquin Spring Lake and Payson. Residents are also concerned about decreased property values and increased air pollution. "The air is clean here now," she said.

Unless annexation is approved, the company will be restricted from expanding its gravel operation beyond its current 36 acre boundary and would not be able to build concrete or asphalt batch plants, said Jeff Mendenhall of the county planning department. He said any change in the county zoning to allow expansion was unlikely.

#### Asphalt plant opposed

All Santaquin, Spring Lake and Payson, residents — as well as all the surrounding areas — should be aware of Valley Asphalt, which is owned by U.S. Aggregate based in California.

The company has petitioned Santaquin City to annex into the city so it can move its asphalt and cement operation to the Santaquin site.

This will be very detrimental to the area in a variety of ways.

Valley Asphalt has said truck traffic will increase to about one every two minutes.

It would use of four million gallons of water every month.

It would increase the pit size from 50 acres to 173 acres.

It would build 90-foot smoke stacks and operate 24-hours a day.

The company has also said it is coming whether they are annexed or not.

Not true. Utah County will not let the asphalt or cement plant operate due to pollution and zoning.

Santaquin City has very little to gain from the annexation — long-term or short.

The issues are many and shouldn't be taken lightly; the decision we make

today will affect our children and grandchildren.

Seek out the facts and let councilmembers know what you think.
