Mayor Crook stated that a city wide survey indicated that 90% of
the citizens were in favor of a sewer system in Santaquin.
Acting on this information the Council, with Marilyn Clayson as
project chairman, had proceeded with the project to this final
Public Hearing. He further stated that home mail delivery had
been an issue in Santaquin and he felt it important to hold both
Hearings and Elections together to encourage a good turn out to
indicate the citizens feelings on these issues.

Bonnie Kay, postmaster, asked to speak on home mail delivery
before the discussion on the sewer project and offered to answer
all questions.

ElRay Davis asked about the location of the mail boxes. Answer -
to be determined by the Postal Service.

LaRue Jarvis asked if Post Office boxes would be available if
home mail delivery were enacted. Answer - Yes but the rental fee

would increase.

Dennis Lamb asked if the snow was not plowed would the mail be delivered. Answer - No.

LaRue Jensen asked about locking neighborhood boxes. Answer - Not sure if they would be available.


Mrs. Kay stated that boxes would never again be placed on the home.
