

MINUTES OF BLOCK GRANT MEETING  
HELD AT THE CITY HALL  
FEBRUARY 3, 1988

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. Marilyn Clayson conducted the meeting under the direction of the Mayor, Lynn Crook. Also in attendance were Val Broadhead, Leslie Broadhead, Curt Stringham, Laurie Lloyd, Sherman Jones, Dennis Lamb, and LaMar Openshaw. The Invocation was offered by Mr. Lamb.

Mrs. Clayson stated that she had discussed grant possibilities with Steve Brown, who is coming tomorrow (February 4) to help fill out the necessary applications for the grant. Mr. Brown thought that the city could apply for a vehicle for EMT, a tank truck for the fire department, and a compressor to refill air packs for the fire department. All of these items would come under one category. Also added to the list of possibilities during the meeting were some more pagers, a fibulator, two jump kits for the police cars, and a pediatric hare traction splint. Mrs. Clayson said that she would check on these items as well. Mr. Crook mentioned the survey that the scouts had done for the grant and Mrs. Clayson stated how proud she was of them and what a good job they had done. Mrs. Clayson briefly explained the survey.

Mr. Broadhead stated that the fire department could use about \$50,000 for equipment that was needed. He agreed to get a letter from the County Fire Marshall stating the need that Santaquin has for a tanker to haul water to fires, especially in the county. Signs for the fire department were also discussed, in particular the need for some kind of plans in order to show what is needed. Mrs. Clayson then addressed Mr. Stringham and some suggestions that he had made in a previous meeting. The first of these being shelves for the library which the city already has and needs someone to install. The second suggestion concerned snow removal which Mrs. Clayson said she would ask Mr. Brown about. Mr. Crook mentioned that he had spoken with Dennis and Wade concerning snow removal and felt that they now had a system worked out that would take care of the problem. The third suggestion was playground equipment which did not apply under the grant. A freeway sign promoting the city was also suggested but it was determined that this would not qualify either. Some statistics were given by the EMT's concerning the types and numbers of calls that they had received during the year.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30pm. NOTE: Parts of this portion of the tape were extremely inaudible and so some information may have been inadvertently omitted. This situation can be rectified as soon as the minutes are reviewed.
