

Minutes of a special Santaquin City Council meeting held Saturday, March 7, 1981 at City Hall at 9:30 a.m. Mayor Robert Steele presided and members of the Council present were: Sherman Jones, Fred Thompson and Floyd Nelson. Councilmen Walter Callaway and Tom McCloud were not in attendance. Members of the Council and press were notified of the meeting during the meeting of March 4, 1981, and the public was notified by public notice posted in three public places.

Mayor Steele called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and Councilman Nelson offered the invocation. Mayor Steele led the pledge of allegiance. Members of the public present were: Mike Olson and Clint Cornwell.

The first item of business was the recommendation of Dr. Blake Gammell to the Conservancy District board. Councilman Thompson moved that the City recommend Dr. Gammell to the Judges of the Fourth District Court. Councilman Jones seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.


Councilman Thompson moved that the Council appoint Mr. Farrel Craig to the Board of Adjustments for Santaquin City contingent upon his acceptance. Councilman Nelson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor Steele explained that the purpose of this meeting was to travel to various sites in the City and look at problems and accomplishments and plan for the future of the City.

Councilman Jones brought out the fact that there were numerous signs which have been placed on the sidewalks in town and asked that these be looked at during the tour.

Councilman Jones moved that the meeting be adjourned and Councilman Thompson seconded. The motion passed unanimously at 9:50 a.m.
