We received new chairs for the internet computers and we have to get a new monitor. Council member Rowley asked if anyone signed up for the teen book club. Directory Oryall commented that we have a couple and we're waiting to see if more sign up. We are waiting to talk to Council Member Montoya who is over the Teen Council. \$500 extra was added in the budget for the teen council to help the library. Chair Harward asked if there were library packages for the younger children. Director Oryall replied yes that is with a different project though, and she is still working on it. Director Oryall asked if anyone would be willing to help with moving books onto the shelves? Chair Harward, volunteer will probably help with

it, the city will be finished building them sometime in September.
