B) TOTAL # OF MUSEUM VISITORS 2019/COMPARED TO RECENT YEARS (ANNETTE)

Museum Board Director Annette Bott compared visitors to prior years. In 2017 there was 1,317. In 2018 there was 998. So far in 2019 there has been 1,195. These numbers include the events. Over 400 people came to the Spooky Night. They were only expecting about 100. They had really good volunteer support. There was a very positive reaction to the spooky night. Over \$400 of donations were received. Board Member Keela Goudy suggested that having the Spooky Night two nights next year. Leisure Services Director John Bradley recommended the idea of concessions. Everyone liked the idea.

C) POTENTIAL SPECIAL EVENTS FOR 2020 (JOHN)

Leisure Services Director John Bradley recommended doing a "Night at The Museum" themed nights based off the movie. Board Member Keela Goudy suggested festival of trees, where volunteers decorate trees and auction them off. Board Member Kim Bahr we could action off the pumpkins that have been carved from Spooky Night. Gouty recommended we could do pioneer day during Orchard Days and have it advertised before.

D) UPDATE ON FACILITY IMPROVEMENT INFORMATION GATHERING (ANNETTE)

Board Member Jake Kester had estimates for a new roof for the museum. We have contacted people who deal with bat problem. A company came and gave a lot of info to go with. The lady works with the wildlife division. What we have learned is that you need to do the roof first. They put valves in so the bats can go out but can't go in. Bats migrate in September-October. Its tricky timing. They seal up the cracks. They can get through very small cracks. Jake Kester has gone ahead and got some estimates, we thought about doing metal roofing, but it doesn't look great. There were two estimates, Asphalt shingles, 35k-50k. 30-year grade 58k. 62k for a 35 year. 40 year 68k. Lifetime 74k. 50-60k Neither one of these will get involved with the raptures for the walls.
