After the meeting had been duly called to order and after other matters not pertinent to this resolution had been discussed, the Deputy City Recorder presented to the Council a Certificate of Compliance with Open Meeting Law with respect to this June 15, 2005 meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

The following resolution was then introduced in writing, was fully discussed, and pursuant to motion duly made by Councilmember Mount and seconded by Councilmember 22 and dev., adopted by the following vite:

The resolution was then signed by the Mayor Pro-Tem and recorded by the City Recorder in the official records of the City. The resolution is as follows:

#### RESOLUTION NO. 06-03-2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,300,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF SALES TAX REVENUE AND REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2005 OF SANTAQUIN CITY, UTAH FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING ALL OR A PORTION OF THE COSTS OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING A NEW PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY AND REFINANCING CERTAIN OBLIGATIONS INCURRED TO FINANCE **PARK ACQUISITIONS** AND PROPERTY **CERTAIN PUBLIC** HEARING AND CALLING A IMPROVEMENTS; ESTABLISHING A TIME, PLACE AND LOCATION FOR SAID PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF A NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND BONDS TO BE ISSUED; PROVIDING FOR A PLEDGE OF SALES TAX REVENUES FOR REPAYMENT OF THE BONDS; FIXING THE MAXIMUM AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE BONDS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF YEARS OVER WHICH THE BONDS MAY MATURE, THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE WHICH THE BONDS MAY BEAR, AND THE MAXIMUM DISCOUNT FROM PAR AT WHICH THE BONDS MAY BE SOLD; PROVIDING FOR THE RUNNING OF A CONTEST PERIOD; AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, Santaquin City, Utah (the "Issuer") desires to finance all or a portion of the costs of acquiring and constructing a new public safety facility and refinance certain obligations incurred to finance certain property acquisitions and park improvements (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Bonding Act, Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended and the Utah Refunding Bond Act, Title 11, Chapter 27, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended (collectively, the "Act"), the City Council (the "Council") of the Issuer has authority to issue its Sales Tax Revenue and Refunding Bonds, Series 2005 (the "Bonds") for the purposes set forth in the first whereas clause; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that prior to issuing bonds secured by excise tax moneys, an issuing entity must (i) give notice of its intent to issue such bonds and (ii) hold a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Issuer desires to call a public hearing for this purpose and to publish a notice of such hearing, including a notice of bonds to be issued, in compliance with the Act with respect to the Bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City Council of Santaquin City, Utah, as follows:

Section 1. The Council of the Issuer hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Issuer and the residents thereof for the Issuer to issue not more than \$1,300,000 aggregate principal amount of the Bonds (defined above), to bear interest at a rate or rates of not to exceed five and one-half percent (5.50%) per annum, to mature in not more than ten (10) years from their date or dates, and to be sold at a price not less than ninety-seven and one-half percent (97.5%) of the total principal amount thereof, for the purpose of financing and refinancing all or a portion of the costs of the Project all pursuant to this Resolution, a resolution to be adopted by the Council authorizing and confirming the issuance and sale of the Bonds (herein referred to as the "Final Bond Resolution"), and a General Indenture, as further supplemented by a First Supplemental Indenture (collectively, the "Indenture") (the form of which is attached hereto), and the Council hereby declares its intention to issue the Bonds according to the provisions of the Indenture and the Final Bond Resolution, when adopted.

Section 2. The Issuer proposes to pledge the Local Sales and Use Tax funds received by the Issuer pursuant to Title 59, Chapter 12, Part 2, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended for repayment of the Bonds.

Section 3. The Issuer hereby authorizes and approves the issuance of the Bonds pursuant to the provisions of this Resolution, the Indenture and the Final Bond Resolution to be adopted by the Council authorizing and confirming the issuance and sale of the Bonds, with such changes to said the Indenture as shall be approved by the Council upon the adoption of the Final Bond Resolution.

Section 4. The Issuer shall hold a public hearing on July 20, 2005 to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds, which hearing date shall be not less than fourteen (14) days after notice of the public hearing is first published, such notice to be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Payson Chronicle, a newspaper of general circulation within the Issuer which is hereby designated as the Issuer's official newspaper pursuant to Section 11-14-316 of the Act. The City Recorder shall also cause a copy of this Resolution (together with all exhibits hereto) to be kept on file in the Issuer's principal offices for public examination during the regular business hours of the Issuer until at least thirty (30) days from and after the last date of publication thereof. The Issuer directs its officers and staff to publish a Notice of Public Hearing and Bonds to be Issued in substantially the following form:

#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND BONDS TO BE ISSUED

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Wednesday, June 15, 2005, the City Council (the "Council") of Santaquin City, Utah (the "Issuer") adopted a resolution (the "Resolution") declaring its intention to issue its Sales Tax Revenue and Refunding Bonds, Series 2005 (the "Bonds") pursuant to the Local Government Bonding Act, Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, and the Utah Refunding Bond Act, Title 11, Chapter 27, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, and to call a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds.

#### TIME, PLACE AND LOCATION OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Issuer shall hold a public hearing on Wednesday, July 20, 2005, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. The location of the public hearing is 45 West 100 South, in Santaquin, Utah. The purpose of the hearing is to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds. All members of the public are invited to attend and participate.

#### PURPOSE FOR ISSUING BONDS

The Issuer intends to issue the Bonds for the purpose of (i) financing all or a portion of the costs of acquiring and constructing a new public safety facility, (ii) refinancing certain obligations incurred to finance certain property acquisitions and park improvements, (iii) funding a debt service reserve fund, if required, and (iv) paying costs of issuing the Bonds.

#### PARAMETERS OF THE BONDS

The Issuer intends to issue the Bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000), to bear interest at a rate or rates of not to exceed five and one-half percent (5.50%) per annum, to mature in not more than ten years (10) years from their date or dates, and to be sold at a price not less than ninety-seven and one-half percent (97.5%) of the total principal amount thereof, plus accrued interest to the date of delivery. The Issuer does not anticipate requiring any deposit with respect to the sale of the Bonds.

#### EXCISE TAXES PROPOSED TO BE PLEDGED

The Issuer proposes to pledge all or a portion of the Local Sales and Use Tax funds received by Issuer pursuant to Title 59, Chapter 12, Part 2, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, for repayment of the Bonds.

The Bonds are to be issued and sold by the Issuer pursuant to the Resolution, a General Indenture, a First Supplemental Indenture, drafts of which were before the Council at the time of the adoption of the Resolution (collectively, the "Indenture") and said Indenture is to be approved by the Council in such form and with such changes thereto as shall be authorized by the Council upon the adoption of a final bond resolution.

A copy of the Resolution and the form of the Indenture are on file in the office of the City Recorder of the Issuer at 45 West 100 South, in Santaquin, Utah, where they may be examined during regular business hours of the City Recorder from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for a period of at least thirty (30) days from and after the last date of publication of this notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a period of thirty (30) days from and after the last date of the publication of this notice is provided by law during which (i) any person in interest shall have the right to contest the legality of the Resolution, the Indenture (as it relates only to the Bonds) or the Bonds, or any provision made for the security and payment of the Bonds, and that after such time, no one shall have any cause of action to contest the regularity, formality or legality thereof for any cause whatsoever, and (ii) registered voters within Santaquin City, Utah may sign a written petition requesting an election to authorize the issuance of the Bonds. If written petitions which have been signed by at least 20% of the registered voters of Santaquin City, Utah are filed with the Issuer during said 30-day period, the Issuer shall be required to hold an election to obtain voter authorization prior to the issuance of the Bonds. If fewer than 20% of the registered voters of Santaquin City, Utah file a written petition during said 30-day period, the Issuer may proceed to issue the Bonds without an election.

Section 5. The Council hereby declares its intention and reasonable expectation to use proceeds of tax-exempt bonds to reimburse itself for expenditures for costs of the Project. The bonds are to be issued, and the reimbursements made, by the later of 18-months after the payment of the costs or after the Project is placed in service, but in any event, no later than three years after the date the original expenditure was paid. The maximum principal amount of the bonds which will be issued to finance the reimbursed costs of the Project is not expected to exceed \$1,300,000.

Section 6. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its approval and adoption.

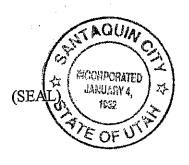
