

RESOLUTION 01-02-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE SANTAQUIN CITY COUNCIL, ENCOURAGING THE NEBO SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ESTABLISH THE APPLE VALLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL'S SOUTHERN BOUNDARY ALONG US-6 MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, continued population growth in Santaquin City has necessitated the construction of a third elementary school within Santaquin City limits by the Nebo School District; and

WHEREAS, the Nebo School District has posted the following advertisement 'Notice of Public Hearing Regarding Changes to School Boundaries' and is seeking public comment regarding the realignment of boundaries between Santaquin Elementary, Orchard Hills Elementary and the new Apple Valley Elementary, by holding a public hearing to be held on January 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Nebo School District has published two proposed boundary alignment plans (*identified herein as Green and Yellow*) for the purpose of seeking public comment; and

WHEREAS, Santaquin City strongly desires the elimination of the hazard posed to children crossing US-6 Main Street to attend school at Santaquin Elementary, due to the high traffic volumes experienced along US-6 Main Street; and

WHEREAS, Santaquin City projects that its future population growth (*see attached map*), will be balanced amongst the three geographic areas created by boundaries established along US-6 Main Street and Interstate-15, which would further lend support to the establishment of elementary school boundaries utilizing these same major geographic barriers; and

WHEREAS, the Santaquin City Council desires now to formally submit its recommendation for the proposed boundary alignment to the Nebo School District for inclusion in the public record of the public hearing dated January 10, 2018;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SANTAQUIN, UTAH:

The Santaquin City Council formally supports Nebo School District Proposed Boundary alignment identified herein as "Yellow", which would extend the southern boundary of Apple Valley Elementary to US-6 Main Street, and thus eliminate the need for children to cross US-6 Main Street to attend school.




