The Planning Commission feels that before they can make any Policy of Annexation the following questions need to be answered and recommendations considered:

Questions:

- Impact Fees: Has there been a decision as to where the City is going to spend this money and if it will be for water development and the updating of the present system?
- 2. Well Permit: Can the extra well permit be moved to another place and is money available for drilling?

## Recommendations:

- 1. That the City obtain water shares rather than money when annexation takes place. If money is accepted, the city should get \$100.00 above the market price of a share.
- 2. That the City have an agressive program for purchasing water shares. It needs to be advertised, for if people knew the City was in the market for shares and that it would go into the water system, they would probably sell to the city.
- 3. That the City select an Advisory Committee to assist the councilman over the water to help investigate for sources of water, help with thinking on water problems, do leg work, etc. It is recommended that one of the members of the Planning Commission be on this council with the City Councilman over water as chairman.
