Mr. Pay called the meeting to order at 8:15 pm. He also said the opening prayer.

<u>Jalynn Steele</u>: Mr. Steele mentioned concern about buying a business license to do work in his own home town when a out of town contractor is not required to. Also contractors are often required to purchase extra licenses.

Grant read requirements for Home Occupation. One concern was employees but since most of Mr. Steele's employees are temporary these commissioners felt there was no problem.

Mr. Kelly cited item G as determiner for this particular case.
Mr. Steele mentioned Price's policy of requiring out of town contractors to pay for a license but not requiring local contractors to.
Mr. Pay explained the main concern was individuals moving in big equipement in their yards with no recourse for the city.

Decision: Mr. Steele would need a business license. It was recommended to the city council to grant this license.
