

Minutes of the Santaquin Planning Commission held May 14, 1991.

Present: Ken Kelley and Jeri Bascom Commission members.  
Petitioners Paula Mooseman, Donna and Doug Schmidt, Edwin and Colleen Ahlin.

Absent: Dee Davis, Glade Robbins, Brenda Wall.

The meeting was called to order by Ken. He also offered the opening prayer. Minutes were postponed because there was not a full quorum of Commission members. Because of the lack of a full quorum the business attended was not official. Because some of the petitioners came in expecting their cases to be heard we went ahead and heard the cases on the condition that no action would be taken in any case until it had been presented to at least one other Commission member. Ken said that he would call and talk to each member that was absent and then get back with each petitioner on their particular case.

Paula Mooseman: Mr. and Mrs. Mooseman are seeking a Home Industry license. They plan to have a woodworking and craft business. They don't plan to have any outside employees. Ken read them the Ordinance (40-3 Sec 25 parts). There were no questions. Mrs. Bascom recommended to accept the application. Ken seconded. Vote unanimous but subject to approval by the yea vote of at least one other Commission member.

Doug and Donna Schmidt: Mr. and Mrs. Schmidt are requesting a Home Industry license for the purpose of a mail-order supply business. They do have a state tax number and have gone through the state and federal governments to set their business up. They would be working as jobbers. Ken recommends for acceptance and Jeri seconds. Vote unanimous but subject to approval by the yea vote of at least one other Commission member.

Edwin Ahlin: Mr. Ahlin is requesting a license for the purpose of making and selling livestock equipment. He will do work on his property as well as away. He will have a building for the storage of his equipment and materials. He is applying for a Home Industry license. He has obtained a state tax number. He will be using a delivery truck. Ken read him the ordinance that was read earlier. Ken recommended acceptance. Jeri seconded. Vote unanimous but subject to approval by the yea vote of at least one other Commission member.

The other business licenses on the agenda. John Capel and Jan Neilson: were tabled because the people did not come in to explain their businesses to the Commission. They will be contacted and invited to the next meeting. The rest of the business on the agenda was also tabled because of the lack of enough members present. This business will also be picked up at the next meeting. The meeting was then adjourned.
